Main Duties: Reporting to directly to the Restaurant & Bar Coordinator and under the supervision of the Restaurant & Bar Supervisor, the Bartender will be responsible to open and close the floor bar and lounge by conducting a physical inventory; Unlock coolers, liquor dispenser and bar cabinet; Set up Lounge for day's business; Ensure an adequate supply of inventory; Prepare drinks and serve customers as required; Enter orders into the POS system; Provide a clean and safe lounge area; Other duties as required by the Restaurant & Bar Coordinator and/or Restaurant & Bar Supervisor and/or Food and Beverage Manager.
