Main Duties: Reporting to the Guest Services Manager, and under the supervision of the Guest Services Supervisor, the Guest Services Representative will be knowledgeable of all aspects of the Players' Club and be able to process Club members' information accurately and efficiently while providing fast, efficient and friendly customer service to patrons. Responsibilities include: Accurately recording messages and other information required and ensuring that messages are delivered promptly; Answering customer inquiries with respect and courtesy and directing calls to appropriate casino personnel and departments; Attending bus tour arrivals and departures, handing out bus packages and greeting the bus patrons; Performing various promotional announcements using a public address system; Handling the coat check of patrons; Responding to patron concerns and questions; Processing valet parking tickets and keys; Accurately entering Players' Club information into the computer in a timely manner; Explaining Players' Club rules, policies, promotions and special events to customers; Assisting in the inventory of Players' Club storage items; Maintaining the Players' Club Bank; Keeping daily promotions, Players' cash and inventory logs accurate, including all paperwork and logs assigned by the Supervisor; Recruiting and enrolling of customers not currently enrolled in the Players' Club; Preparing written reports on incidents or discrepancies; Handling all information acquired with a high level of confidentiality; Other duties as assigned by the Guest Services Supervisor and/or Guest Services Manager.
